Direct Integration Vendor Guidance for UCDP Freddie Mac Proprietary Findings



The following excerpts are from the Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac Uniform Collateral Data Portal[®] (UCDP[®]) Technical Integration Guide Version 1.5.

To ensure your systems are prepared to incorporate Freddie Mac proprietary hardstops and findings for appraisal submissions, please confirm that your systems are in compliance with the following portions of the specification.

Get Findings (Version 1.5 – pages 33-44)

Get Findings Request (Control Input):

- 1. Confirm if your "_RETURN_FILE" element within the "GET_FINDINGS_REQUEST" element has one of the following values within the "_FileType" attribute:
 - a. "FRE_FINDINGS_XML"
 - -AND/OR-
 - b. "FRE_FINDINGS_HTML"
 - i. If it DOES NOT, then please update your DI solution to include these values
 - ii. If it DOES, then test within the UCDP Integration environment when available. Consult your Freddie Mac Vendor Contact for assistance.

Get Findings Response (Control Output):

- 1. Confirm if you are able to accommodate receiving a "GET_FINDINGS_RESPONSE" element with the following:
 - a. Freddie Mac Proprietary Hard Stops (Available Mid 2014) which are identified by:
 - i. The "HARD_STOP" element being populated
 - ii. ONLY a value of "FRE" populated in the "HARD_STOP_INVESTOR" elements " Name" attribute

NOTE: Joint GSE Hard Stops would have both "FRE" and "FNM" values listed for the "HARD_STOP_INVESTOR" elements "_Name" attribute"

- b. Freddie Mac Proprietary Findings which are identified by:
 - i. The "FINDINGS_SUMMARY" element being populated with the following:
 - a. A value of "FRE" in the "_Investor" attribute
 - b. A value of "HTML" or "XML" in the "_Format" attribute
 - c. The name for the Business Output MIME Section containing the Freddie Mac Proprietary Findings
 - d. The filename containing the Freddie Mac Proprietary Findings in the "_Filename" attribute

Get Findings Response (Business Output):

- 2. Confirm if you are able to accommodate receiving the Freddie Mac Proprietary Findings through the GET FINDINGS Business Output "FINDINGS_MESSAGE_LOG" element which is identified by the filename (e.g. FRE_FINDINGS_DocumentFileID.XML) and MIME section name (e.g. BO_FRE_XML) specified in the FINDINGS_SUMMARY element from the Control Output and contains the following:
 - a. The "FINDINGS_MESSAGES" element that will have a value of "FRE" in the "Investor" attribute
