



## **Loans Delivered In Quarter**

➤ New business activity of \$99 billion, up from \$98 billion in the third quarter of 2024







# **Closed Repurchase Demands By Review Type**



#### **Highlight:**

- Repurchase volume on performing loans decreased by 5% in 3Q25 vs 2Q25
- Decrease in repurchase count primarily due to reduction in income defects offset by an increase in collateral-related defects (e.g., condos in need of critical repairs), seller self-identified defects, and isolated charter-related defects (e.g., Non-QM loans, condotels)

UPB included is Last Known UPB prior to repurchase


Confirmed Fraud repurchases indicate loans where the fraud investigations group confirmed fraud and sent loan for repurchase

## **Defect Categories**



## **Highlight:**

- > Population includes only loans resulting in repurchase with origination review types.
- Income defects have decreased 5% since Q1 2025 from 40% of all defects on repurchased loans to 35% in Q3 2025
- Collateral defects such as critical repairs and wet basements have increased in recent quarters leading to collaterals 23% of all defects in Q3 2025
