




# A Deep Dive into History

- A history of intensive resource extraction and profound human exploitation not seen to the same degree elsewhere in the U.S.
- The goal of the landowning class was to build vast wealth off the backs of laborers.
- In each place, one industry linked to national and global markets had come to dominate the economy, a pattern which held broadly into the 1960s.
- This economic pattern had emerged (or, in the case of the Cotton Belt, had fully flourished) in the late nineteenth century, reaching it's zenith in the 1920s and 30s.
















## This Pattern was not New!

- Not only were these places scarred by the deep resource extraction and human exploitation of the distant past, but...
- These were the very places that gave the war on poverty it's face
- If we did not uncover the mechanisms liking the present to the past,
   we might be looking at the same map in the future







#### U.S. Skills Map: State and County Indicators of Adult Literacy and Numeracy





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


#### County-level Social Capital Levels, 2014





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
## Deaths by Interpersonal Violence Deaths in American Communities



## Our Map of Deep Disadvantage Compared to a Map of Enslavement from 1860





Children's Chances of Reaching Top 20% of Income Distribution Given Parents in Bottom 20%



# Takeaways

- History casts a long shadow.
  - Housing conditions and needs often reflect decades' old economic and social relations within a place.
- By combining big data, ethnography, and history, the *mechanisms* connecting past to present are revealed.
- Uncovering the mechanisms can lead to innovative policy solutions.

# Policy

- Separate and unequal schooling must end
  - To end violence, spark mobility
    - Invest in social infrastructure
      - Root out corruption
- Make structural racism visible, confront it
