Salability / Early Eligibility Message

Loan Quality Advisor is being enhanced to provide lenders early visibility, prior to delivery, into whether a non-LPA loan may be ineligible for sale to Freddie Mac.

The following new message will display in Loan Quality Advisor Message section:

LPA Data Compare Message Rewrite

Freddie Mac is updating Loan Quality Advisor LPA Data Compare messages with 113 revised LPA Data Compare feedback messages to provide more consistent and actionable messaging. The following are focus areas for the revised messages:

- Add LPA data reference points for: Project Legal Structure Type, Construction Method Type and Attachment Type
- Expand acronyms to remain compliant with standards
- Remove acronyms to remain compliant with standards
- Rewrite messages for consistency
