



Updates to UCD v2.0 Specification Resources

Freddie Mac and Fannie Mae (the GSEs) published updated Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) v2.0 Specification (UCD v2.0) resources to help lenders and software/technology service providers prepare for UCD v2.0 adoption and transition to Phase 3B Postponed and Phase 4 edits. The UCD v2.0 Specification Initiative is focused on improving data quality for single-family loans acquired by the GSEs.

Transition Preparation

As a reminder, the GSEs recommend that customers take the following steps to prepare for UCD v2.0 and critical edit transitions:

- Familiarize yourself with the scope of UCD v2.0 changes by downloading and reviewing UCD v2.0 resources on the GSEs' UCD websites.
- Review all phases of the UCD Critical Edits Matrices to understand the new and revised Phase 3B Postponed and Phase 4 requirements.
- Update any internal processes, procedures and training materials to support implementation.
- If applicable, conduct integration testing with the GSEs early and often to resolve issues.
- Review the UCD v2.0 Initiative Readiness Checklists for lenders or direct integrators, as appropriate.


UCD v2.0 Specification Initiative Timeline Update

The GSEs are currently evaluating production data results for Phase 4 and will announce Phase 4A and 4B critical edit subsets in Q1 2026. The mandate dates for UCD v2.0, Phase 3B Postponed, and Phase 4 critical edits will also be provided at that time. The mandate dates will begin no earlier than Q3 2026.
